„Weck, Worscht un Woi“ & “Meenzer Spundekäs mit Brezelchen”

“Woi” – ABC**Schoppe:**

If you order a Schoppe, you will usually receive 0.2 liters of wine mixed with 0.2 liters of mineral water to make a wine spritzer. The exact ratio between wine and water can vary.

Halbe:

Meenzer pronounce it “Halwe”, meaning a quarter liter of wine.

Racheputzer:

You will hopefully only very rarely encounter inharmonious wines, also known as Racheputzer, during your visit to Mainz.

Schoppestecher:

This is how Meenzers refer to all people who like to drink their Schoppe.
